

As part of our partnership with the Tooro Kingdom, we plan to launch eSusFarm in 2024 and establish a research center where we can jointly develop technologies; we plan to support the tourism sector in Tooro Kingdom by setting up a Tourism school under our esteemed Faculty of Business and Management. The school will be linked to our Bachelor's program in Tourism and Hospitality Management, equipping students with the necessary skills and knowledge to excel in this industry.

We will also conduct research with the Tooro Kingdom on various environmental projects that will contribute to the preservation and conservation of the region's natural resources. Likewise, we are also partnering with Across the Nile Resort in Jinja to establish a practical center for hospitality and tourism.

The accreditation of our ODeL marks a significant stride towards providing accessible and flexible learning options for the digital age and it takes our vision and mission beyond borders. In our pursuit of global collaboration and academic excellence, we have forged strong partnerships. In a few days, a delegation from IUEA will be heading to Dubai to participate in COP28 international conference on climate change. There, we will discuss climate financing, greenhouse gases and forge more partnerships.

These partnerships are a testament to our commitment to fostering a culture of collaboration and knowledge sharing. To end the list, let me inform you that IUEA is the first university, probably in Africa, to develop a Climate-Smart Agriculture curriculum! We are proud of this!



The regenerators intend to start with one tractor and then, once they are done with tests, they will determine how many to roll out in the village OX-4 TRACTORS. The tractor has two unique aspects. Unlike other tractors which are powered by diesel or gasoline engines, the OX-4 runs by electric hub motors, which are powered by four rechargeable batteries.

#### IUEA in Partnership with Global Regenerators Made the First Electric Tractor in Africa

The International University of East Africa has partnered with Regenerators, who have manufactured the first tractor ever made in Africa from scratch. The 25-horsepower, four-wheel tractor called OX-4, was designed by Oggun, a US-based company, which provided the blueprint.
